## Scholarship Outgoing USA Academic Year 2024

One **scholarship** within the DAAD-funded program at the HTWG "**HAW.International – Global Get-Together**" is available for students doing an exchange semester or year at a HTWG partner university in the US. The scholarship is intended to help students cover the costs of their academic studies in the US. It is only available for students with <u>a very good GPA</u>, and who are not receiving a scholarship or funding from another institution.

## Scope of the scholarship:

Flight Germany-USA at €1.075 and 4 months of financial support at €1.150 per month = €4.600

Please submit the following scholarship application documents to the **HAW.International** – **Global Get-Together** coordinator, Cornelia Lindenau (<u>cornelia.lindenau@htwg-konstanz.de</u>). **The application deadline is April 15**<sup>th</sup>, **2024**. - Letter of motivation (ONE DINA4 page, max. 4 MB) with answers to all of the following questions in English:
- Are you receiving Bafög or are planning to apply for Auslandsbafög? Are you planning to apply for other scholarships? If yes: when will you find out?
- How has the perspective of possibly studying abroad changed/re-focused your current study objective(s)?
- Which institution are you applying for, and why?
- How are you planning to prepare for your semester aboard?
- How are you planning to combat any prejudices you may have?
- Which worries do you have and how are you planning to address them?
- Your CV
- Transcript of grades
- Certificate of enrollment

All application documents are considered in the selection process. We anticipate a scholarship decision around the end of April, beginning of May.

Awarding of scholarships: Once selected, you sign a contract stating that you accept the scholarship. This contract also specifies the amount and length of the scholarship. After successfully completing the stay abroad, you receive a DAAD scholarship certificate. Upon return you send a final report as well as answers to a short pre-structured questionnaire. Furthermore, you agree to report on your own experiences to prospective students at an information event.
