A degree from Germany is recognized worldwide and opens up excellent opportunities on the job market in Germany, the EU, and around the world.

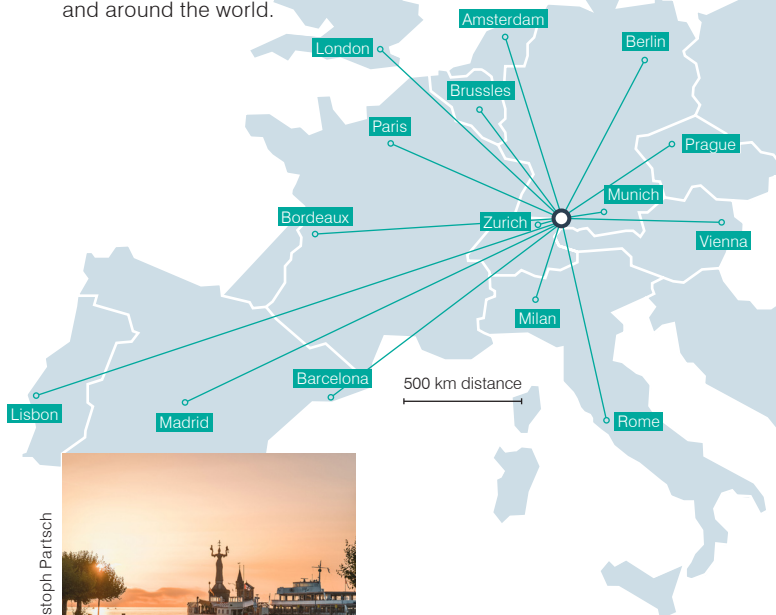
