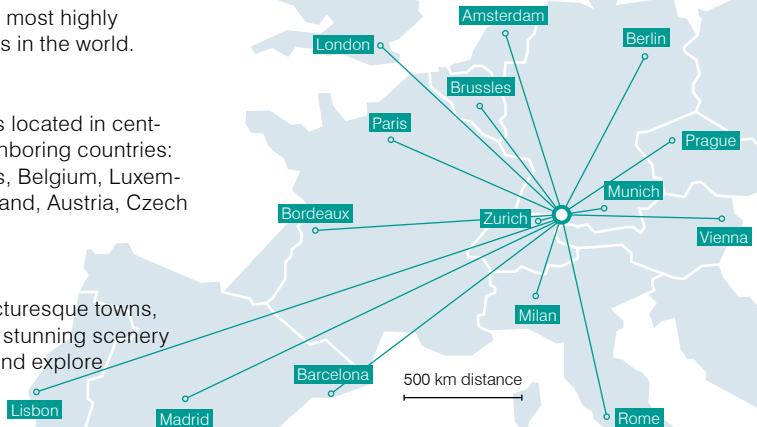
Study abroad at Lake Constance, Germany

Why Germany?

Germany is one of the most highly industrialized countries in the world.

The city of Konstanz is located in central Europe with 9 neighboring countries: Denmark, Netherlands, Belgium, Luxembourg, France, Switzerland, Austria, Czech Republic and Poland.

The city of Konstanz is located in the southernmost part of Germany within walking distance from the Swiss border. Konstanz has a population of 80.000 of which 15.000 are students, making Konstanz **the largest and most exciting city on Lake Constance**.

Because of its prime location, it is the **gateway for many outdoor activities** such as skiing, hiking, sailing, etc. Aside from the city's beauty, Konstanz is renowned for its high performance in industry and its innovative R&D facilities.

Free time and leisure activities

Konstanz offers endless possibilities for leisure activities such as theatres, museums, cinemas, bars, clubs and outdoor sports. There are also plenty of concerts throughout the year.

Popular destinations such as the famous **Swiss Alps**, the **Rheinfalls** (the largest waterfall in Europe), the **Black Forest**, the city of **Zurich, Freiburg, Munich**, and **Stuttgart** are only a train ride away.

Incoming exchange students at advanced undergraduate or graduate levels are invited to participate **in a semester or an academic year exchange program** beginning in either the March, or the September terms.

The HTWG offers a **wide range of English taught courses** in the fields of business, business law, engineering and computer science. Exchange students **with substantial knowledge of German** are welcome to attend any course at HTWG.

German **language courses** during the semester are offered at all skill levels along with courses in **Business German** and **Technical German**.

For exchange students there are **no additional tuition/program fees** at HTWG.

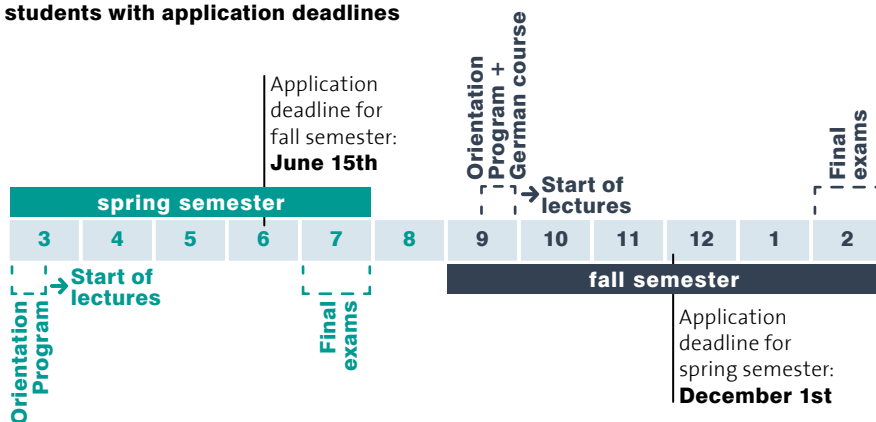
HTWG also offers **scholarship opportunities** to exchange students.

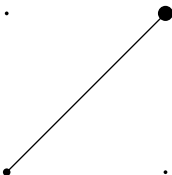
